

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Camandag, Leon, Iloilo

23 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 September 2023 at around 12NN, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Camandag, Leon, Iloilo between the 61st Infantry Battalion of the Philippine Army and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA).
