





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol

18 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 September 2023 at around 7:30AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Ilaud, Brgy. Campagao, Bilar, Bohol, between the Philippine Army's 47th Infantry (Katapatan) Batallion and the alleged members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA).

Affected populace sought temporary shelter at the Campagao Covered Court for a night and have returned to their respective place of origin on the following day with no augmentation request received by the concerned LGU. Thus, the termination of this report.
