
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Napangan, Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental

23 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On September 17, 2023, the 10th Infantry Battalion – Philippine Army Detachment in Barangay Nueva Vista (Mansawan), Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental, conducted a blocking operation in Barangay Napangan, engaging in a two-hour encounter with individuals suspected to be members of the Communist Party of the Philippines – New People’s Army (CPP-NPA).

The incident led to displacement of families and individuals. Furthermore, the affected families have now returned to their respective habitual residences.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, through its Field Office in Region X, along with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Don Victoriano, assessed the situation and promptly intervened to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

300 families or **945 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Napangan, Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **300 families** or **945 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Napangan, Don Victoriano Chiongbian, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱315,600.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱135,600.00** from the **DSWD** and **₱180,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
