

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Sipalay City, Negros Occidental

19 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 16 September 2023 at around 5PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Gil Montilla, Sipalay City, Negros Occidental between the Philippine Army's 15th Infantry Battalion and members of the Communist Party of the Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) that also affected a nearby village of Brgy. San Jose also in Sipalay City.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **47 families** or **186 persons** were affected in **Sipalay City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **39 families** or **153 persons** sought temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Sipalay City, Negros** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **33 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **47 families** or **186 persons** were displaced in **Sipalay City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱123,751.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱105,421.00** from **DSWD** and **₱18,330.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
