

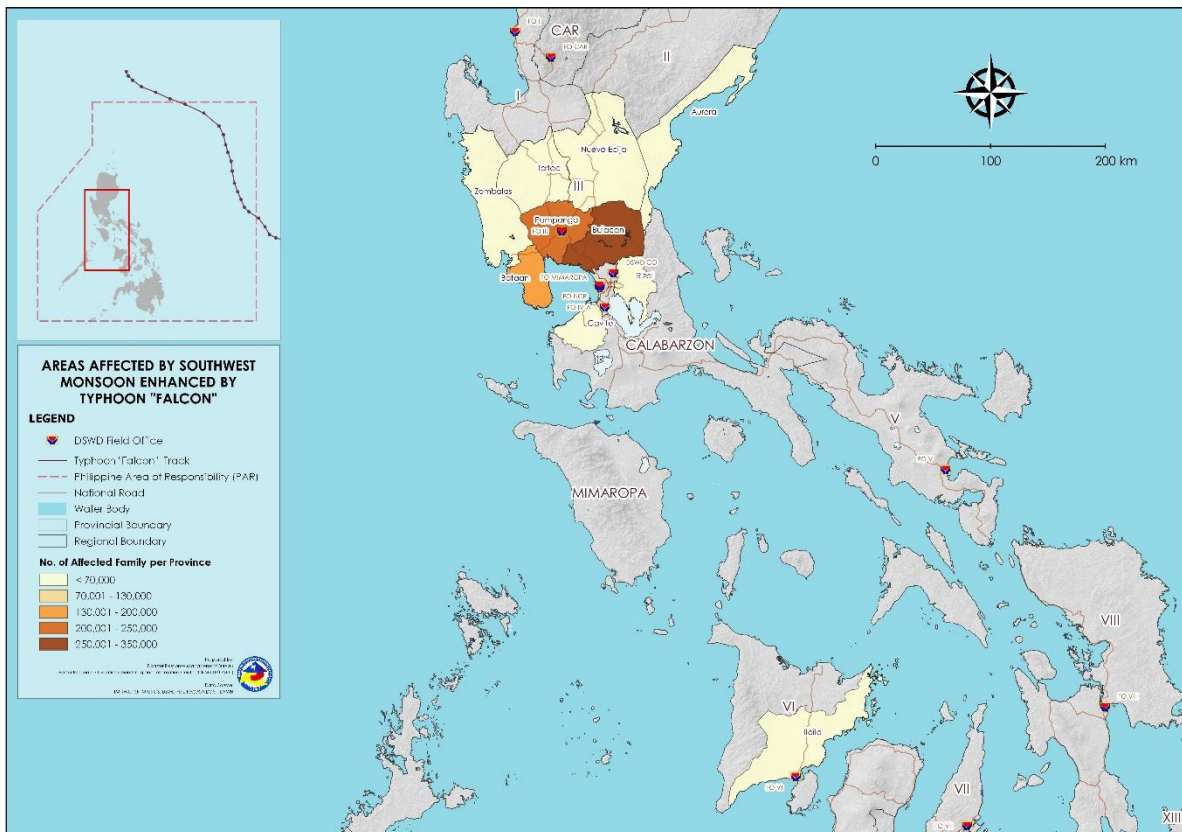
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon enhanced by Typhoon “Falcon”

16 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 July 2023, the Tropical Storm “Khanun” has entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and was named “Falcon”. On 30 July 2023, “Falcon” intensified and became a Typhoon. As “Falcon” intensified while moving North Northwestward over the Philippine Sea, the Southwest Monsoon enhanced by Typhoon “Falcon” has brought occasional to monsoon rains over the western portion of Luzon and Visayas. “Falcon” left the PAR on 01 August 2023.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **805,445 families** or **3,159,365 persons** were affected in **1,266 barangays** in **Regions I, III, CALABARZON, and VI** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **19 families** or **113 persons** taking temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Regions III** and **CALABARZON** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **13,496 families** or **49,428 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **19 families** or **113 persons** still displaced in **Regions III** and **CALABARZON** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **538 houses** were damaged; of which, **105** are **totally damaged** and **433** are **partially damaged** in **Regions III, CALABARZON, and VI** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱419,787,886.59** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱341,653,253.56** from **DSWD**, **₱76,900,237.35** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, and **₱1,234,395.68** from **other Partners** (see Annex F).
