

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ususan, Taguig City

24 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On September 06, 2023 at around 9:17 AM, a fire incident occurred at 93 Ibayo MP Cruz, Barangay Ususan, Taguig City. The fire was officially declared out at 9:59 AM.

A total of 30 families, comprising 104 individuals, were affected by the fire. Among them, 14 families with 51 individuals, sought shelter inside evacuation center. Simultaneously, 16 families with 53 individuals found refuge with their relatives in nearby areas. Affected families have already returned to their habitual residences.
