## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Tantaran, South Cotabato

09 February 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 September 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to Southwest Monsoon or localized thunderstorms might have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day, several barangays in Tantaran, South Cotabato experienced flash floods due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,421 families** or **7,105 persons** were affected in **eight (8) barangays** in **Tantaran, South Cotabato** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **230 families** or **1,150 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **New Iloilo Gym** in **Tantaran, South Cotabato** (see Annex B).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱929,334.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
