





# **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incidents in Davao Region**

27 November 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 08 September 2023 at around 11:00 PM, a flash flood incident occurred in Brgy. Concepcion Asuncion, Davao del Norte due to localized thunderstorms.

On 14 September 2023, several more municipalities in the provinces of Davao de Oro, Davao del Norte, and Davao Occidental also experienced flash floods due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the Southwest Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms.

A total of **12,539 families** or **48,275 persons** are affected in **29 barangays** in **Region XI** (see Table 1).
