

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental

20 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 September 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at around 3:45: PM, flooding was experienced in a low-lying area in Brgy. Daug, Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms.

A total of **223 families** or **770 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Community Center** in **Hinoba-an, Negros Occidental** (see Table 2).
