





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Padada, Davao del Sur

21 November 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 23 September 2023 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by the Southwest Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of Mindanao area.

On the same day, several barangays in Padada, Davao del Sur experienced flooding due to heavy rainfall caused by the Southwest Monsoon.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of 11 families or 44 persons sought temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Padada, Davao del Sur (see Table 2).
