

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incidents in Cebu

21 May 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 September 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by either the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) or localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 10:30 PM, several barangays in the Municipality of Compostela and Danao City in Cebu experienced flooding due to heavy rainfall brought by localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **590 families** or **953 persons** were affected in **12 barangays** in **Region VII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **173 families** or **536 persons** sought temporary shelter in **four (4) evacuation centers** in **Region VII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **170 families** or **170 persons** displaced with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **590 families** or **953 persons** were displaced in **Region VII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **28 houses** were damaged; of which, **16** are **totally damaged** and **12** are **partially damaged** in **Region VII** (see Annex E).
