

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Mw 6.3 Earthquake Incident in Calayan, Cagayan

17 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 September 2023 at 7:03 PM, a 6.3-magnitude earthquake jolted the Municipality of Calayan, Cagayan (19.26°N, 121.13°E - 019 km N 25°) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus 031 km. The earthquake was also felt in the neighboring municipalities.

A total of **25 families** or **87 persons** were affected in **Calayan, Cagayan** (see Table 1).
