I. Situation Overview

On 03 September 2023 at around 9AM, a residential structure collapsed due to soil erosion caused by continuous heavy rainfall in Valenzuela City.

Inside Evacuation Center There are **27 families** or **104 persons** displaced in Valenzuela City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of eight (8) houses were totally damaged in Valenzuela City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱222,710.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
