06 May 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 September 2023 at around 9AM, a residential structure collapsed due to soil erosion caused by continuous heavy rainfall in Valenzuela City.

A total of **eight (8) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Valenzuela City** (see Annex C).

A total of **₱222,710.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
