

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Brgy. Canlusong, Enrique B. Magalona, Negros Occidental

as of 20 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 17 October 2023 at around 5:15 PM, an armed conflict transpired between the troops of the 79<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion (IB) – Philippine Army and members of the Communist Terrorists Group – New People’s Army (CTG-NPA) at Sitio Nabalas Dos, Brgy. Canlusong, Enrique B. Magalona, Negros Occidental.

A total of **533 families** or **2,665 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Canlusong, Enrique B. Magalona, Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).
