- 133,144 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 90,776 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,368 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 52,339 FFPs available at DSWD FO III.
- ₱479.83 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO III warehouses.
