1. Standby Funds

- ₱16.54 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 157,762 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 115,394 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,368 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 42,908 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱504.31 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
