## 1. Standby Funds

- ₱21.63 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 103,616 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 87,848 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 15,768 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 42,136 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱668.97 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.
