as of 17 October 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 October 2023 at around 5:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 1, Brgy. Masara, Maco, Davao de Oro. Based on the investigation, it was determined that the fire was caused by a faulty electrical wiring. The fire was declared out at around 7PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱16.54 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 169,130 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 127,762 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 41,368 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
