#### 1. Standby Funds

- ₱16.53 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

#### 2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 117,250 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 74,882 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 42,368 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 44,064 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱429.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
