I. Situation Overview

On 31 August 2023 at around 10:35 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tupsan, Mambajao, Camiguin. The fire was declared out at around 1:00 PM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 107,560 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 42,622 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 64,938 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
