1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 130,494 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 48,026 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 82,468 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 8,651 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱300 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
