

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Strong Wind Incident in Brgy. 20, Manila City as of 05 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 01 October 2023, a strong wind incident occurred in Brgy. 20, Manila City due to localized thunderstorms causing damaged to several houses.
