On 08 October 2023 at around 7:14 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Kalamagan and Sitio Agsam in Brgy. Limulan, Kalamansig, Sultan Kudarat between the troops of the Philippine Army and members of an unknown armed group that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals.

11 October 2023	 DSWD FO XII closely coordinated with the MSWDO of the LGU of Kalamansig, Sultan Kudarat for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.
09 October 2023	 The LGU of Kalamansig, Sultan Kudarat, through its MDRRMO and MSWDO, conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Need Analysis (RDANA) in the affected areas.
