

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo as of 05 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 29 September 2023 at around 9:52 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Cagay, Leon, Iloilo between the forces of Philippine Army 61<sup>st</sup> Infantry Battalion (IB) and the members of Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) Sibat Platoon, Southern Front, Komiteng Rehiyon – Panay.

On the same day at around 8:32 PM, another encounter occurred between the said armed groups, this time within vicinity of Brgy. Nalbang, Leon, Iloilo.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **473 families** or **1,984 persons** are affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Leon, Iloilo** (see Table 1).
