

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Region XII

as of 26 October 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 October 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, the Municipalities of President Quirino and City of Tacurong in Sultan Kudarat and the Municipality of Tantangan in South Cotabato experienced heavy rainfall and flash floods brought by localized thunderstorms.
