

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 90, Caloocan City as of 13 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 October 2023 at around 12:28 PM, a fire incident occurred at 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Brgy. 90, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 1:39 PM.
