I. Situation Overview

On 24 October 2023 at around 9:53 AM, a fire incident occurred at De Lara Compound, Balagtas St., Brgy. Moonwalk, Parañaque City. The fire was declared out at around 12:23 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- 109,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 94,209 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 15,768 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,194 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
