

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flash Flood Incident in Bonifacio, Misamis Oriental

as of 13 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 October 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon / localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, several barangays in the Municipality of Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental experienced flash flood due to localized thunderstorms.
