



# **DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the** Flooding Incident in Midsayap, North Cotabato

as of 17 October 2023. 6PM

#### **Situation Overview** Ι.

Issued on 26 September 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon / Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 6:00 PM, low-lying barangays in the municipality of Midsayap experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.
