

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Leon, Iloilo

21 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 September 2023 at around 9:52 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Cagay, Leon, Iloilo between the forces of Philippine Army 61st Infantry Battalion (IB) and the members of Communist Party of the Philippines – New People's Army (CPP-NPA) Sibat Platoon, Southern Front, Komiteng Rehiyon – Panay.

On the same day at around 8:32 PM, another encounter occurred between the said armed groups, this time within the vicinity of Brgy. Nalbang, Leon, Iloilo.
