





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Chikungunya Outbreak in Paracelis, Mountain Province

07 April 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 25 August 2023, the Local Government Unit of Paracelis in Mountain Province declared State of Calamity due to the outbreak of Chikungunya cases in the municipality.

Chikungunya is a mosquito-borne viral disease caused by the chikungunya virus (CHIKV), an RNA virus in the alphavirus genus of the family Togaviridae. Chikungunya is a disease transmitted to humans by mosquitoes mostly in Africa, Asia, and the Americas; sporadic outbreaks have also been reported in other regions. Chikungunya causes fever and severe joint pain, which is often debilitating and varies in duration; other symptoms include joint swelling, muscle pain, headache, nausea, fatigue, and rash.
