

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Region XII

07 April 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 October 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms due to localized thunderstorms may have caused possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, the Municipalities of President Quirino and City of Tacurong in Sultan Kudarat and the Municipality of Tantaran in South Cotabato experienced heavy rainfall and flash floods brought by localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,180 families** or **5,900 persons** were affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Region XII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **272 families** or **1,360 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **54 families** or **270 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **54 families** or **270 persons** were displaced in **Tacurong City, Sultan Kudarat** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **47 houses** were damaged; of which, **two (2)** are **totally damaged** and **45** are **partially damaged** in **Region XII** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱787,324.00** worth of assistance was provided **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
