

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon and Typhoon Jenny

16 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 29 September 2023, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Central Luzon entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) and developed into Tropical Depression “Jenny”. On 30 September 2023, “Jenny” became a Tropical Storm. On 01 October 2023, “Jenny” intensified into a Severe Tropical Storm and enhanced the prevailing Southwest Monsoon bringing occasional to monsoon rains in several areas of the country. On 02 October 2023, “Jenny” further intensified into a Typhoon while moving over the Philippine Sea. On 03 October 2023, “Jenny” maintained its strength as it moved North Northwestward over the Philippines. On 04 October 2023, “Jenny” slightly weakened as it commenced its West Northwestward turn towards Southern Taiwan. On 05 October 2023, “Jenny” further weakened and is already outside PAR. On 06 October 2023, “Jenny” continuously weakened and was no longer directly affecting the country.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **172 families** or **251 persons** were affected in **six (6) barangays** in **Regions II and VI** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

a. **One (1) family** or **one (1) person** sought temporary shelter at the **Kaychanarianan Evacuation Center** in **Basco, Batanes, Region II** (see Annex B).

b. **Outside Evacuation Center**

A total of **148 families** or **169 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. **Total Displaced Population**

A total of **149 families** or **170 persons** were displaced in **Regions II and VI** (see Annex D).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and **25** are **partially damaged** in **Region VI** (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱112,955.31** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱103,235.31** from **DSWD** and **₱9,720.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
