
DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Naga-Naga, Palo, Leyte

23 December 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 October 2023 at around 2:48 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Naga-Naga, Palo, Leyte. The fire was declared out at around 5:00 PM.

In response, the DSWD Field Office VIII together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Palo, Leyte, assessed the situation and promptly intervened to address the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals by providing Food and Non-Food Items (NFIs) and financial assistance.

Consequently, the LGU of Palo, Leyte already managed the IDPs and is committed to continuously provide interventions as necessary hence, the termination of this report.

A total of **three (3) families** or **12 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Naga-Naga, Palo, Leyte** (see Annex A).

A total of **three (3) families** or **12 persons** are still temporarily staying at **Barangay Naga-Naga Hall** in **Palo, Leyte** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Naga-Naga, Palo**. (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱53,811.62** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
