

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy Rizal, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

21 December 2023, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 27 October 2023 at around 12PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Rizal, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. Based on the investigation conducted by the Bureau of Fire Protection, the cause of fire was allegedly due to unattended flames from a cook stove. The fire was declared out at around 1:55 PM.

## II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **58 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Rizal, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **nine (9) families** or **58 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **nine (9) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6)** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Rizal, San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱45,922.02** worth of assistance was provided by to the affected families; of which, **₱36,922.02** from **DSWD** and **₱9,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
