

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental

18 February 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 04 October 2023, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon / localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, several barangays in the Municipality of Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental experienced flash floods due to localized thunderstorms, resulting to displacement to a hundred of families and individuals.

Relative to the incident, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental, promptly provided intervention to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **113 families** or **410 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **113 families** or **410 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **113 houses** were damaged; of which, **12** are **totally damaged** and **101** are **partially damaged** in **Bonifacio, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱43,844.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
