## **DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Midsayap, North Cotabato**

11 February 2024, 6PM

### **I. Situation Overview**

Issued on 26 September 2023 at 4AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms caused by Southwest Monsoon/Localized Thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms to Metro Manila and the rest of the country.

On the same day at around 6:00 PM, low-lying barangays in the municipality of Midsayap experienced flooding due to localized thunderstorms.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region XII provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

A total of **2,232 families** or **11,160 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Midsayap, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).
