

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte

as of 08 November 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 November 2023 at around 6AM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Bugawas, Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte.

According to reports, the armed encounter was between two (2) Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) groups that resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **1,017 families** or **5,085 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Table 1).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **545 families** or **2,725 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Datu Odin Sinsuat, Maguindanao del Norte** (see Table 2).
