#### I. Situation Overview

On 07 November 2023, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Tukanalipao, Mamasapano, Maguindanal del Sur between a group belonging to the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and an unidentified armed group that resulted in the displacement of families and persons

A total of **840 families** or **4,200 persons** are affected in **Mamasapano**, **Maguindanal del Sur** (see Table 1).

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **80 families** or **400 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Tuka Elementary School** in **Mamasapano**, **Maguindanal del Sur** (see Table 2).
