





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies

as of 09 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 November 2023, the effects of Easterlies were reported in Iligan City, Lanao del Norte after several barangays experienced flash flood and flooding. On the same day, flash flood in Brgy. Caridad, Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat and a rain-induced landslide along Sitio Lower Ladol, Brgy. Assumption, Koronadal City occurred due to the presence of the said weather disturbance.

On 08 November 2023, several barangays in Davao City also experienced flooding that resulted in the displacement of families and persons.

A total of 2,051 families or 7,867 persons are affected in 11 barangays in Regions X, XI, and XII (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,194 families or 5,220 persons currently taking temporary shelter in seven (7) evacuation centers in Regions X, XI, and XII (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱29.16 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱14.2 million available at DSWD FOs X, XI, and XII.
- ₱65.9 million available in DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies through inter-FO augmentation.







2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 137,170 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 116,102 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,068 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 146,622 FFPs available at DSWD FO X, XI, and XII.
- 911,385 FFPs in DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies through inter-FO augmentation.
- ₱262.6 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO warehouses.
