

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 846, Manila City

as of 20 November 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 November 2023 at around 7:55 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 846, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 9:45 PM.

A total of **97 families** or **337 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 846, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **97 families** or **337 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Covered Court** in **Brgy. 846, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **39 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 846, Manila City** (see Annex C).
