1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 124,898 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 110,330 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 14,568 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,016 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱843.8 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.

c. Internally Displaced Person (IDP) Protection

d. Camp Coordination and Camp Management (CCCM)

6 November 2023	 The LGU of Quezon City through the SSDD activated its CCCM and other response clusters, and closely coordinated with concerned offices for the needs of the affected families and individuals.

7 November 2023	 DSWD FO NCR through its Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) maintained close coordination with the LGU of Quezon City for significant updates and any requests for relief augmentation.
