I. Situation Overview

On 23 October 2023 at around 10:00 AM, a fire incident transpired at Purok 2 and 5, Brgy. Lam-an, Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **22 families** or **81 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Lam-an Evacuation Center** in **Ozamis City, Misamis Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** are totally damaged in **Brgy. Lam-an**, **Ozamis City**, **Misamis Occidental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱550,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
