I. Situation Overview

On 04 November 2023 at around 7:00 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Little Venice, Laoang, Northern Samar.

- 140,170 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 111,502 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,668 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 112,103 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱883.39 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.
