I. Situation Overview

1. Standby Funds

- ₱29.16 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VIII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 140,170 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 111,502 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,668 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 112,103 FFPs available at DSWD FO VIII.
- ₱883.39 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VIII warehouses.

DSWD FO VIII referred the affected families to the Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) for the further provision of financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS). DSWD FO VIII requested the MSWDO of Laoang to provide Psychological First Aid (PFA) to the affected families and individuals. |
