

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Panghulo, Obando, Bulacan

as of 28 October 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 October 2023 at around 09:53 AM, a fire incident occurred at Enriquez St. (San Lorenzo), Brgy. Panghulo, Obando, Bulacan.

A total of **16 families** or **57 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Panghulo, Obando, Bulacan** (see Table 1).
