I. Situation Overview

On 24 October 2023 at around 09:53 AM, a fire incident occurred at Enriquez St. (San Lorenzo), Brgy. Panghulo, Obando, Bulacan.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱21.63 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO III.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 109,977 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 94,209 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 15,768 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 52,339 FFPs available at DSWD FO III.
- ₱707.22 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO III warehouses.
