1. Standby Funds

- ₱29.16 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 135,970 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 107,302 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 28,668 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

24 October 2023	 DSWD FO VII, in coordination with its Municipal Action Team (MAT) and the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the LGU of Pamplona, Negros Oriental, distributed FNIs such as FFPs, kitchen kit, sleeping kit, hygiene kit, and family kit to the affected individual.
17 October 2023	The MSWDO of the LGU of Pamplona, Negros Oriental provided food packs and housing materials to the affected individual.


c. Other Activities

08 November 2023	 DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with the LGU of Pamplona, Negros Oriental for significant updates and any further requests for relief augmentation. DSWD FO VII referred the affected individual to its Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) in Negros Oriental for assessment and possible provision of financial assistance through Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS).
