1. Standby Funds

- 73,305 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 55,799 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 17,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 43,568 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱1.03 billion worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.
